About IIPHS:

The Indian Institute of Public Health Shillong (IIPH-Shillong) is a northeast regional institute of public health. It was established in 2015 by the PHFI in collaboration with the Government of Meghalaya to redress the limited institutional and systems capacity in public health in the North East Region of India. IIPH-Shillong is an autonomous educational & research institute of the IIPH Shillong Society, registered under the Meghalaya Society registration Act of 1983.

Project Title and Brief:

Health Coverage in Meghalaya - A survey of availability, accessibility, affordability, and quality of healthcare

This project is funded by the National Institute of Health and Care Research (NIHR) and jointly conducted by the Institute of Economic Growth (IEG) and O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Public Health Shillong (IIPHS). This survey is the first comprehensive survey of treatment-seeking behaviour of individuals and households in Meghalaya, that will seek to understand expenditures incurred for OPD, IPD, and chronic conditions and the extent of health coverage, types, and depth of coverage offered, the extent of use of such coverage. The survey will also collect information on patient behaviour vis-à-vis choice of providers, perceived quality of providers, and use of health coverage.

In the context of India's rollout of Universal Health Coverage, the results of the survey would provide important inputs into policy-making for the Government of Meghalaya.

Qualifications:

Essential

- Graduate in any discipline from a recognized university/institute.
- Written and oral fluency in local language and English.
- Proven experience in conducting field research and data collection in health projects.
- Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal.

Desirable

- Master's Degree in Public Health, Business Administration, and allied health discipline.
- Proficiency in using electronic data collection tools and software platforms (e.g., KOBO, ODK).

• Ability to work independently in field settings, demonstrating resilience, adaptability, and problem-solving skills.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- a) Conduct field surveys and interviews in designated communities or target populations following established research protocols and methodologies.
- b) Travel to field sites to collect and record data appropriate to the project's specific objectives.
- c) Coordinate survey logistics, including scheduling, mapping out survey locations, and managing transportation arrangements.
- d) Monitor and troubleshoot survey implementation issues, promptly addressing any challenges or deviations from the research protocol.
- e) Review and edit data to ensure completeness and accuracy of information; follow up with subjects to resolve problems or clarify data collected.
- f) Provide regular progress updates and participate in team meetings to discuss survey outcomes, challenges, and potential modifications to the research approach.
- g) Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.
- h) Assist in the development and translation of interview schedules into the local language.
