Functional Brief:

The Indian Institute of Public Health Shillong is envisioned as hubs of teaching, research, collaboration and advocacy in the evolving multidisciplinary field of public health. The IIPH-Shillong was established in collaboration with the Government of Meghalaya (GoM) by the PHFI in 2015. IIPH Shillong as of 2020, is an autonomous entity of the Indian Institute of Public Health Shillong Society registered under the Meghalaya Societies Registration Act of 1983.

The institute aims to redress the limited institutional and systems capacity in public health in the northeast region of India. The northeast region of India is largely populated by ST or indigenous peoples. The region is poorly developed and many areas have poor health indices. IIPHS aims to improve health outcomes in the region through educational, research, training, policy and advocacy activities. The mandate of IIPHS include capacity strengthening and improving health outcomes through engagement in research, education, training, policy and advocacy activities that is relevant to the region and the country.

- Teaching Public Health, especially pertaining to social and behavioral science related topics
- Undertake teaching for on-campus and eLearning programs.
- Assess and monitor student performance across modules for on-campus and eLearning programs.
- Mentor students and guide student dissertations and internship activities.
- Design teaching-learning material to support student learning.

- Mentoring students in course work including their research project
- Conduct need based trainings on various public health topics
- Take up relevant research, develop research proposals and lead grants
