About IIPHS:

The Indian Institute of Public Health Shillong (IIPHS) is a northeast regional institute of public health. It was established in 2015 by the PHFI in collaboration with the Government of Meghalaya to redress the limited institutional and systems capacity in public health in the North East Region of India. In August 2020, IIPHS became an autonomous institution of the IIPHS Society registered under the Meghalaya Societies Registration Act 1983. The mission of IIPHS is to advance equitable health and wellbeing by fostering a culture of excellence in education, research and praxis.

Project Brief:

The Regional Resource Hub for Health Technology Assessment in India (RRH-HTAIn) at IIPH Shillong in collaboration with the Department of Health Research, Government of India is undertaking cost-effectiveness analysis on behalf of MoHFW. The purpose of HTAIn is to support informed policy making through economic evaluation, cost effectiveness analysis and related HTA studies.

Roles and responsibilities:

- 1. Undertake evidence synthesis of different health technologies and health intervention.
- 2. Collaborate with the Government and Development partners to generate evidence in the area of cost effectiveness of health care programs
- 3. Undertake evaluation of health policies and programs from an economic perspective
- 4. Explore e-learning or on-campus academic courses in the area of HTA
- 5. Develop, maintain and establish web-based source of HTA information
- 6. Responsible for overall activities of the center under the guidance of the PI
- 7. Prepare study designs, develop decision tree and Markov model, formulate the model in spreadsheet, statistical analysis, write reports and disseminate results.
- 8. Liaison with the government officials, health care professional and community leaders
- 9. Line managing of junior research staff
- 10. Assist in developing project related budgets and other related admin work
- 11. Maintain log of work and process and provide quarterly reports
- 12.Prepare reports, manuscripts, datasets for publication and presentations for varied audiences including DHR and other agencies
- 13. Any other tasks assigned by the supervisor.
