IIPH-Shillong aims to redress the limited institutional and systems capacity in public health in the northeast region of India and focuses on capacity strengthening and improving health outcomes through engagement in research, education, training, policy and advocacy activities that is relevant to the region and the country.

DURATION

The programme is divided into **4 semesters** over a period of **2 years**.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates having **MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BNYS, BSMS, BVSc. and BSc/Msc degree in Life/Population Sciences/Bachelors in Non-Life Science streams** will have to undergo **1 year Bridge course**

The MPH course in IIPH-Shillong attempts to prepare competent cadre of professional who have a basic understanding of the various aspects of public health and are able to successfully apply this knowledge towards meeting public health challenges in the Indian context.

Public Health Programmes demand a special emphasis on the study of disease epidemiology, various determinants of health & emerging challenges in health, public policy making and programme management.
