Project Brief:

The Indian Institute of Public Health Shillong (IIPHS) is conducting an ICMR-funded project on the "Epidemiology of soil-transmitted helminths in Meghalaya". The overall goal of this project is to understand the disease burden of STH infection in humans, animals and environment, and the STH transmission mechanisms in communities with close human-animal interaction.

Deliverables:

- 1. Carry out community surveys, collect and process stool samples.
- 2. Will be responsible for maintaining safety and quality standards for samples collected and for all equipment used.
- 3. Responsible for proper labelling, storage and maintenance of the stool samples collected.
- 4. Responsible for transport of samples from the field site to IIPHS
- 5. To have close coordination with the field team and laboratory members at IIPHS
- 6. Involvement in field work as and when necessary.
- 7. Maintain detailed log of field work and provide periodic reports to the Principal Investigator
- 8. Liaison with health workers, village/community leaders to ensure quality and timely completion of work.
- 9. Prepare work plan and schedule for research project.
- 10. Identify delays and deviations and accordingly revise work plan to ensure timely completion.
- 11. Any other project or institution related activities as may be assigned from time to time.
- 12. Will be required to work as per the requirement of the project/location of work.

- 1. Minimum Qualification: Diploma/Bachelors/Masters in Medical Laboratory Technology
- 2. Knowledge of the local language (Khasi/Pnar)
